This course will run from 8:30 am until 6:00 pm daily and will be held at the Northlands College Campus in Stony Rapids.

Course Dates: Tues. January 8th to Monday, January 21st including weekends.

- Infection control
- Anatomy & Physiology
- Shock
- Emergency Scene Management
- Patient Assessment
- Airway Maintenance
- Artificial Ventilation
- Oxygen Administration
- Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation

- Soft Tissue Injuries
- Chest Injuries
- Head & Spinal Injuries
